

MSL30122 Certificate III in Laboratory Skills



This qualification covers the skills and knowledge required to perform a limited range of laboratory operations across all industry sectors and is the entry level required for laboratory personnel across all industry sectors.

Employment outcomes targeted by this qualification include laboratory technicians, instrument operators and similar personnel.

Laboratory technicians perform straightforward laboratory work. They follow set procedures and apply well developed technical skills and basic scientific knowledge. They generally work inside a laboratory but may also perform technical tasks in the field or within production plants. They may also perform a range of laboratory maintenance and office tasks.

The majority of their work involves a predictable flow of parallel or similar tasks within one scientific discipline.

Course fees depend on individual eligibility for government support. If you are unsure whether you qualify for a government supported training place, please contact our team on 0418 995 730. Credit transfers may reduce the course fee payable.

For students eligible for government support

\$325 – concession student co-contribution fee (\$25 per competency), payable upon enrolment

\$650 – non concession student co-contribution fee (\$50 per competency), payable upon enrolment

Co-contribution fees represent the total cost to the student to enrol in, undertake training, and be awarded the qualification. Students will no longer be eligible for a government subsidised training place under the Career Start Program upon enrolling into a Certificate III apprenticeship / traineeship, or another qualification.

For students not eligible for government support

\$4500 – fee for service student tuition fee

To secure your place in class, a \$300 deposit is payable upon enrolment (EFT facilities are available). This amount is deducted from the total course fee. Fortnightly direct debit payment plans are available to distribute payments of the remaining balance (\$4200) over a 16 week period (8 x fortnightly payments of \$525).
